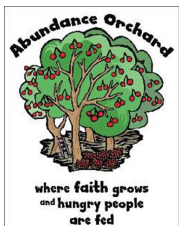

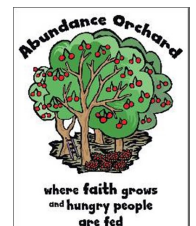

**MISSION** Mission Team News  


We would like to thank all of you who helped with the collection of supplies for the "Cleaning Buckets" for UMCOR. This was a project we participate in every year before the Virginia

United Methodist Church Annual Conference. We decided to focus on the cleaning buckets this year because of the vast amount of storms in the past year including hurricanes, flooding, and tornados. These buckets filled with items such as dish soap, laundry detergent, clothes lines, gloves, trash bags, air freshener, and many other items will be a huge help to the recipients who have experienced major loss and are trying to get their houses or businesses cleaned up. Because of your generous support, we were able to fill 13 five-gallon buckets with the items on the list and even had one leftover bucket with a few more items. These buckets were delivered to the Living Waters District office near Petersburg. A very large truck is driving around the Virginia Conference and picking up these hundreds of buckets and delivering them to an UMCOR warehouse in Pennsylvania where they will be distributed as needed across the country.

Our Society of St. Andrew "Penny Project" is going well. Many of you are bringing in those pennies and other coins. Please keep that going. We will be finding out much more about this project during Vacation Bible School this year as this will be our mission focus. There will be several activities planned for the children to discover what the Society of St. Andrew does to feed the hungry and try and solve the problem of "food waste". Stay tuned for more info on this!

The City of Franklin Parks and Recreation Department is in collaboration with Kaboom and the Virginia Foundation for Healthy Youth to build a new playground at the College Drive Park. If you would like to participate in some way in this 3-day event, please let me (Ruthie Ponder 757-620-9142) know or you can let the church office know. We would like to have a representation from our church there. This will take place on July 10, 11, & 12 from 8:00 to 4:00 each day. There are various ways to participate, not all actually require building skills. We do have to register to participate. You don't have to be there every day or even all day any day. We are awaiting more information on a chance to help with a house near Boykins that has had some roof issues and has leaks. The family in this house has a child on hospice at this time. We hope to be able to help this family in some way as soon as an evaluation is completed. There are several groups working together to get this done. We will keep you updated on this project. Please keep this project and this family in your prayers.

The High Street Mission Garden has been started and things are growing despite some interest and nibbling from some groundhogs and deer. Stop by sometime and take a look. You might see some tomato plants, corn, beans, sweet potato plants, squash, Brussel sprouts, and even some flowers. The main part of the garden's produce is to be donated to the Food Bank here in Franklin. There are some individual plots as well that will donate a portion of their produce. Thanks to Jeff Brown and Mike Ponder for their persistence and hard work on getting this going again. They are still looking for more volunteers to help with watering, a little weeding, and help with harvesting when the time is right. Please contact Jeff, Mike or Kathy Brown if you're able to help once in a while. There are still opportunities to volunteer with the Foodbank of Western Tidewater right here in Franklin. Their building is located at 618 South Street, and you can call 757-544-9027 to find out their volunteer opportunities.

As usual we always accept items for donation to the Franklin Cooperative Ministries here in Franklin. As most of you are aware they have switched their focus to hygiene and household items. You may bring any of these items to church and place them in the boxes or baskets in the narthex and near the church office. A list of the needed items is below.

The Mission Team usually sponsors an Ice Cream Social later in the summer as a thank you for all of the support our High Street UMC family gives us throughout the year. Stay tuned on Facebook and in the bulletins for more information about this!

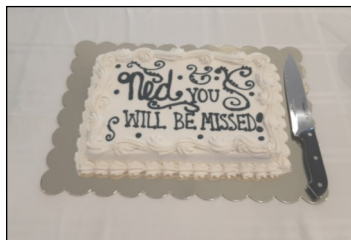
### Lexi Fox Baptism

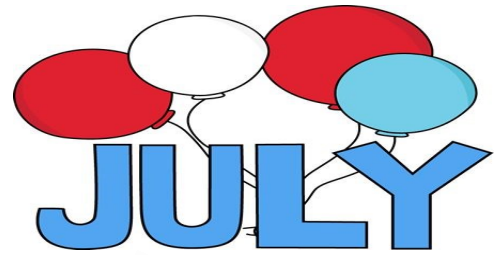


