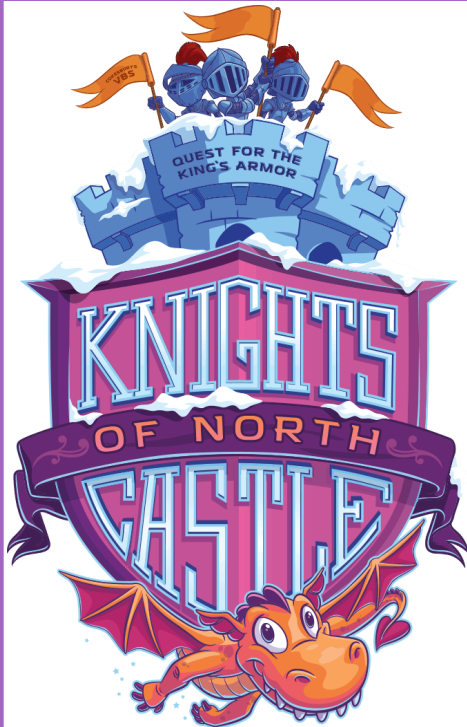

To register for Vacation Bible School, go to www.highstreetumcva.org and select VBS Registration. All participants and volunteers (youth and adult) must pre-register.

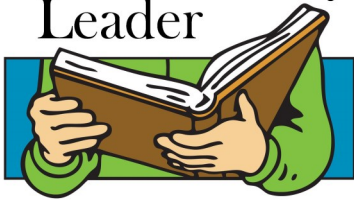

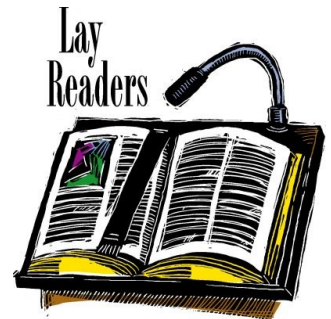


As we move out of the pandemic and resume Worship Services at High Street UMC, there is a huge need for Lay Minister VOLUNTEERS—

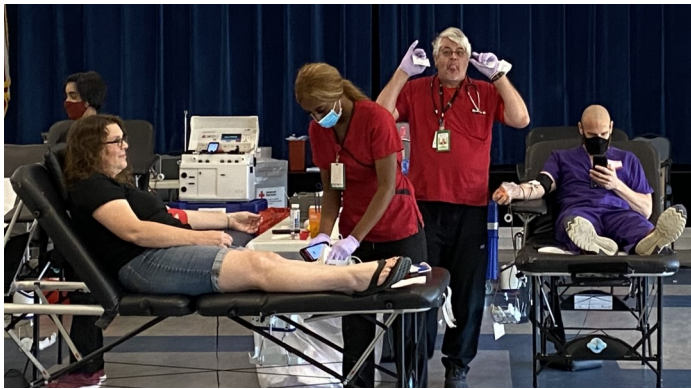


Join Us!

Things have been a little slow with the Mission Team, but hopefully we will start back up with some of our projects over the summer and be up to full speed by the fall. Thanks to those of you who have supported our school supply collection for Riverdale Elementary School's summer remedial program.

We are continuing our support of Franklin Cooperative Ministries' Food Pantry. They have experienced a sharp drop-off in people requesting food assistance most likely due to all the extra food support in our area and through the government. There will not be a "Christmas in July" collection or program this summer. As you may remember, for many years the area United Methodist churches got together and collected food and paper products for the Franklin Cooperative Ministries because their donations were always low in the summertime. Then we would

all get together for a Christmas service. Of course we didn't do it last summer due to the pandemic. This summer the FCM is full of food, so they would prefer to put this off until requests for food assistance pick up. **HIGH STREET WILL BE COLLECTING 16-18 ounce JARS OF PEANUT BUTTER IN JULY. TO MAKE IT A LITTLE MORE FUN, WE ARE SETTING A GOAL OF 100 JARS OF PEANUT BUTTER! Let's see if we can reach this goal by the end of July!!**



Stay tuned for news on the up-start of the work on the "Mission House". Hopefully they will be getting started within the next 2 months.

As soon as I get some information about the restarting of the "Backpack Program" in the fall, I will pass it along to those who are interested in helping out again. We will be financially supporting this program again as we have done for the past 8 years. We will publicize the sponsorship amount for the 2021-2022 school year as soon as I know it. You can always make a donation of any amount at anytime. Thanks for your continued support of this worthwhile local food assistance program.

Lastly, our penny collection is continuing, and we are working on finding a replacement for what project this money will fund.
