He and his wife had retired after many years of faithful service, but Jacques is continuing on in the aviation ministry until a replacement can be found. The funds for our donation of \$2,250 per year for this program are raised through the Lenten Cross Butterflies and the Advent Tree of Stars. The following is a brief description of what this program accomplishes to help the people of this country who are in many cases isolated and cut off from each other and the services and supplies they need to survive. Thank you for your continued support.

The Democratic Republic of Congo, 3 times the size of Texas, has less than a thousand miles of paved road, so transportation is a very serious problem. Therefore, the UMC in the Congo has been using airplanes to spread the Good News of our Lord Jesus Christ since 1960.

The Wings of Caring Aviation Ministry provides transportation to church leaders, doctors, missionaries and critically ill patients. The mission plane also serves as the local post office, transporting mail from one mission station to another. It allows doctors to visit clinics in the interior more easily. Many lives have been saved physically and spiritually because of the plane's service.

Part of the funds raised through the Lenten Cross of Butterflies also go to help fund projects for our Mission of the Month projects such as Heart Havens, the Genevieve Shelter, hygiene kits for UMCOR and many more.
